Diamond and Lace Pullover for Baby

Size: Standard Baby 10 lbs. for baby*

Please read all of the directions before you begin knitting.

YARN DESCRIPTION:

*acrylic 4 ply 70D Artisan midgauge machine

GAUGE DATA:

Gauge 20.0 sts by 32.0 rows.

Body knit by Artisan *70D using TD9

Ribbing knit by Artisan *70D using TD8

FINISHED DIMENSIONS: (ins): ... with Moderate fit.

Chest: 19.8 Armhole: 8.3 Top Neck Opening: 4.4

Front Neck Width: 2.2

Front Neck Depth: 1.8

Hem Width: 19.8 Sleeve Bottom: 5.1

Sleeve Length: 6.0

Body Length: 9.6 Hem Length: 0.8 Collar Length: 0.7

Hem Length: 0.8

Dimond Lace and Garter Stitch

Worked on a multiple of 7 plus 1 sts.

Needle set up for pattern: Always transfer O stitch to the adjacent needle on the right. Patten set up: X = needle with stitch; O = empty needle

3R garter st pattern: R1: transfer sts to ribber, knit across, R2: transfer sts to MB, knit across, R3: transfer sts to ribber, knit across

3R garter st pattern

(MB set up as folows)

3R garter st pattern

Diamond Lace Pattern Insertion: Start diamond lace and garter stitch pattern on row 8 or 1" after garter stitch band. R 1-3: K 3 R garter stitch, R 4-5: K2R, R 6-10: complete diamond

after garter stitch band. R 1-3: K 3 R garter stitch, R 4-5: K2R, R 6-10: complete diamond lace design starting and transferring the 7th stitch from the end to start the lace pattern on the body of the sweater (#3), R 11-12: K2R, R 13-15: K3 R garter stitch, transfer stitches to the main bed (MB) and continue knitting following the directions. Please see diamond lace pattern graphics above for lace and garter stitch pattern.

NOTE: At most, 51 needles are required to knit the body of this garment; but the collar/hood needs 54 needles.

BACK:

1. Cast on 51 sts in MY, using TD9 and closed edge method. Work in garter stitch or hem pattern of choice for 6 rows.
2. Reset row counter to 0. Working in Dimond Lace and Garter Stitch, knit 38 rows.
3. Mark this row at both ends for armhole.
4. Knit 34 more rows. Total 72 rows.
5. Back neck. Thread center 22 sts onto WY. 15 sts each side. Knit 6 rows with WY.

FRONT:

- 1-2 Follow steps 1 and 2 as for back. COR.
3. Armhole. Mark this row at both ends for armhole. Work 18 rows (56 rows total).
4. Shape neck. COR. Thread center 12 sts to WY. 20 sts each side.
5. Right neck. LH needles in HP. Dec 1 st at neck edge every row 5 times, until 15 sts remain. Knit 11 rows even. Total 72 rows.
6. Cut yarn, leaving a 21.0 ins end. Knit 6 rows WY. Place sts in HP.
7. Left neck. COL. Work as for right neck, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES:

1. Cast on 29 sts in MY, using TD9 and closed edge method. Work in garter stitch or hem pattern of choice for 6 rows.
2. Reset row counter to 0.
3. Inc 1 st at each end of every 4th row twice, then every 5th row 6 times to 45 sts (38 rows total).
4. Knit even to total 42 rows. COR.
5. Cast off loosely.

RIGHT SHOULDER SEAM:

1. Graft shoulder seam on 15 sts.

ROUND (CREW) FRONT NECK SINGLE BAND COLLAR:

1. Bring out 54 needles to HP. With wrong side of work facing, rehang 22 sts from back neck holder, 10 sts from left front neck edge, 12 sts from front neck holder and 10 sts from right front neck edge. Hang hem. Push needles to FWP, latches open. Use TD8 with COR.
2. Garter stitch 6 rows. Cast off loosely.

LEFT SHOULDER SEAM:

FINISHING:

- 1. Sew sleeve top to armhole, easing to fit. Sew side and sleeve seams using invisible seam. Sew any remaining seams.**
- 2. Darn/weave/sew in all loose ends.**

NOTES:

Optional Button Neck Band: Please note that the garter stitch neck band is knitted first leaving the left shoulder open. **Left Back Shoulder:** Picking up the shoulder stitches including the stitches from the neck band, garter stitch 4 rows and bind off. **Front Left Shoulder:** Picking up the shoulder stitches including the stitches from the neck band, K2 R garter stitch, counting 3 stitches from the neckline make your first button hole, centering your second button hole within the remaining stitches accordingly. K 2 R more in garter stitch (4 R total) and bind off.

* Depending on the type of bind off method you use, you may want to decrease your neck rows to 5R garter stitch, transfer sts to the MB, and BO. The sample was BO by crochet method, knitting 5R garter stitch.

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
